Definition Clarifications:

Occult. Intentional service of Satan.

Cult Religion.

- (1) A cult is an authoritarian, elitist religious sect who teaches that salvation hinges on membership in their organization, whose members are controlled almost entirely by a single individual, doctrine or by an organization. Cults are usually manipulative and demand total commitment and loyalty from its followers.
- (2) A cult is also defined as any group that deviates from the orthodox teachings of the historic Christian faith derived from the Bible and confirmed through the ancient ecumenical creeds. Most cults sell their religion as a recovery of true Christianity, which was lost until they came on the scene.

<u>Colossians 2:16-23</u> is a key biblical text that warns against any cult or philosophy of religion that stresses human works (i.e., things like legal obedience, ceremonies, dietary rules, secret names, wardrobe rules, asceticism, or other works you can perform and supposedly achieve holiness or salvation through ritualized self-denial.)

Pseudo-Christian Cults.

Pseudo-Christian cults deny or distort fundamental Christian doctrines such as the Trinity, the deity of Christ, and salvation by grace through faith alone. Examples of cults falling into this category are the Mormons, Jehovah's Witnesses, Seventh-Day Adventism, Christian Science, The Way International, and the Unity School of Christianity. Most of these cults claim to be Christian, and even consider the Bible to be authoritative, but manipulate the Scriptures to fit their own beliefs. Although they may claim to serve Jesus Christ, and may even use the same terminology orthodox Christians use, their definitions are vastly different. These groups do not lead to the Christ of the Bible, but to another Jesus and another gospel (2 Cor. 11:1-4; Gal. 1:8,9).

Wicca.

Wicca draws from the old traditions of witchcraft. While Witchcraft and Wicca are similar in many respects, they are not the same. One can be a Witch, without being a Wiccan - Wicca is a recognized religion, while Witchcraft itself is not considered a religion. Thus, Wicca might best be described as a modern religion, based on ancient Witchcraft traditions.

New Age.

New Age is a term applied to a range of spiritual or religious beliefs and practices that developed in Western nations during the 1970s. Precise scholarly definitions of the New Age differ in their emphasis, largely as a result of its highly eclectic structure. Although analytically often considered to be religious, those involved in it typically emphasize beliefs outside the mainstream (such as reincarnation, holism, pantheism, and occultism) that advance alternative approaches to "spirituality" and rarely use the term "New Age" themselves. Theologically, the New Age typically adopts a belief in a holistic form of divinity that imbues the entire universe, including human beings themselves. There is a strong emphasis on the spiritual authority of the self. This is accompanied by a common belief in a wide variety of semi-divine non-human entities, such as angels and masters, with whom humans can communicate, particularly through the form of channeling.
